- 1 When entering your PIN at the ATM always shield the numbers with your hands.

- Do not give out your PIN, card number or account number to anyone including relatives or friends.
- Only enter your PIN when prompted to do so by the ATM.
- If the machine retains your card, do not leave the ATM site without notifying your bank.
- 6 Never accept help from a stranger; call your bank.
